A. GRAMMAR - DEFINING RELATIVE CLAUSES (Mệnh đề quan hệ xác định)

- Dùng để **xác định chính xác người, sự vật, hiện tượng, sự việc** đang được nói tới trong câu là ai, cái gì, vấn đề nào.
- **Chức năng: bổ sung ý nghĩa** cho danh từ hoặc cụm danh từ đứng trước nó.
- Chúng ta **không thể lược bỏ** mệnh đề quan hệ xác định của câu vì sẽ làm thay đổi ý nghĩa của câu đó.
- Cấu trúc và ví dụ:

	WHO/THAT	WHICH/THAT
Cách dùng	là đại từ quan hệ chỉ người, làm chủ ngữ hoặc tân ngữ	là đại từ quan hệ chỉ vật, làm chủ ngữ hoặc tân ngữ
Công thức	... N (chỉ người) + who/that + V + O. ... N (chỉ người) + which/that + S + V.	... N (chỉ vật) + which/that + V + O. ... N (chỉ vật) + which/that + S + V.
Ví dụ	- The man who/that is sitting by the fire is a policeman. - I know the girl who/that you met yesterday.	- This is the book which/that won the prize. - I bought Mary a book which/that she's always loved.

* **Note:** N = noun: danh từ; S = subject: chủ ngữ; V = verb: động từ; O = object: tân ngữ.
