



MODAL VERBS OF SPECULATION:



Argentina often experiences strong cold snaps during winter, especially in the south. The coldest temperature recorded was -32.8°C in Sarmiento, Chubut. Even cities like Buenos Aires can feel the chill. During these times, people wear layers and shelters open to help those in need. Cold snaps can cause transport delays and affect daily life.

LUCÍA, 16

Cold snaps in Patagonia can't be easy. It must snow for days, and the wind must be terrible. If I lived there, I would help elderly neighbors stay warm. I imagine small children might not go to school, and families must stay inside most of the day.
