

An **object pronoun** is used in place of the noun that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.

| Person                   | Singular Object Pronouns | Plural Object Pronouns |
|--------------------------|--------------------------|------------------------|
| 1st (speaking)           | me                       | us                     |
| 2nd (being spoken to)    | you                      | you                    |
| 3rd (being spoken about) | him/her/it               | them                   |
