The Beaches

The beaches in Wales are long and sandy. The Pembrokeshire coastline is about 300 km long. To walk along it, you need about two and a half weeks! You can see lots of wildlife here including dolphins, sharks and turtles.

Colwyn Bay, in north Wales, is a good place to visit. It's got beautiful beaches and you can do water sports including jet skiing and sailing. The Gower Peninsula, in south Wales, has also got fantastic beaches and lots of caves. You can take surfing lessons on the beach or you can go to the nearby city of Swansea and visit the indoor surf centre!

The Mountains

Wales is one of the most mountainous areas in the UK. The highest mountain range in Wales is in Snowdonia in north Wales. Mount Snowdon is the highest mountain at 1,085 m. Around 350,000 visitors a year walk or climb to the top. There's also a train to take you to the restaurant at the top! The Cambrian Mountains are another beautiful range. These are in mid Wales and there's only one road across them. The Black Mountains are a range in mid and west Wales. They're part of the Brecon Beacons National Park. There are many small villages, churches and farms there.
