C Yes, you do.

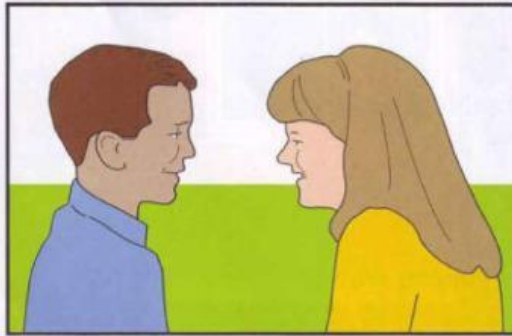
6 **Jill:** Oh, I must go home now.
