Basic Email Structure Table (Greeting – Body – Closing)

Part		Function	Example sentences
Greeting		Opening, saying hello	Hi Adam, Hello Adam,
Body	Ask	Ask Adam to go to the cinema with you on Saturday	Do you want to go to the cinema with me on Saturday? Would you like to watch a film together this Saturday?
	Say	Say what film you want to see	I want to see the new Spider-Man film. Let's watch "Frozen 2", it looks great!
		Say how you will get there	We can go by bus from my house. I'll ride my bike to the cinema.
Closing		Ending the email, saying goodbye	See you soon! Your friend, [Your name]

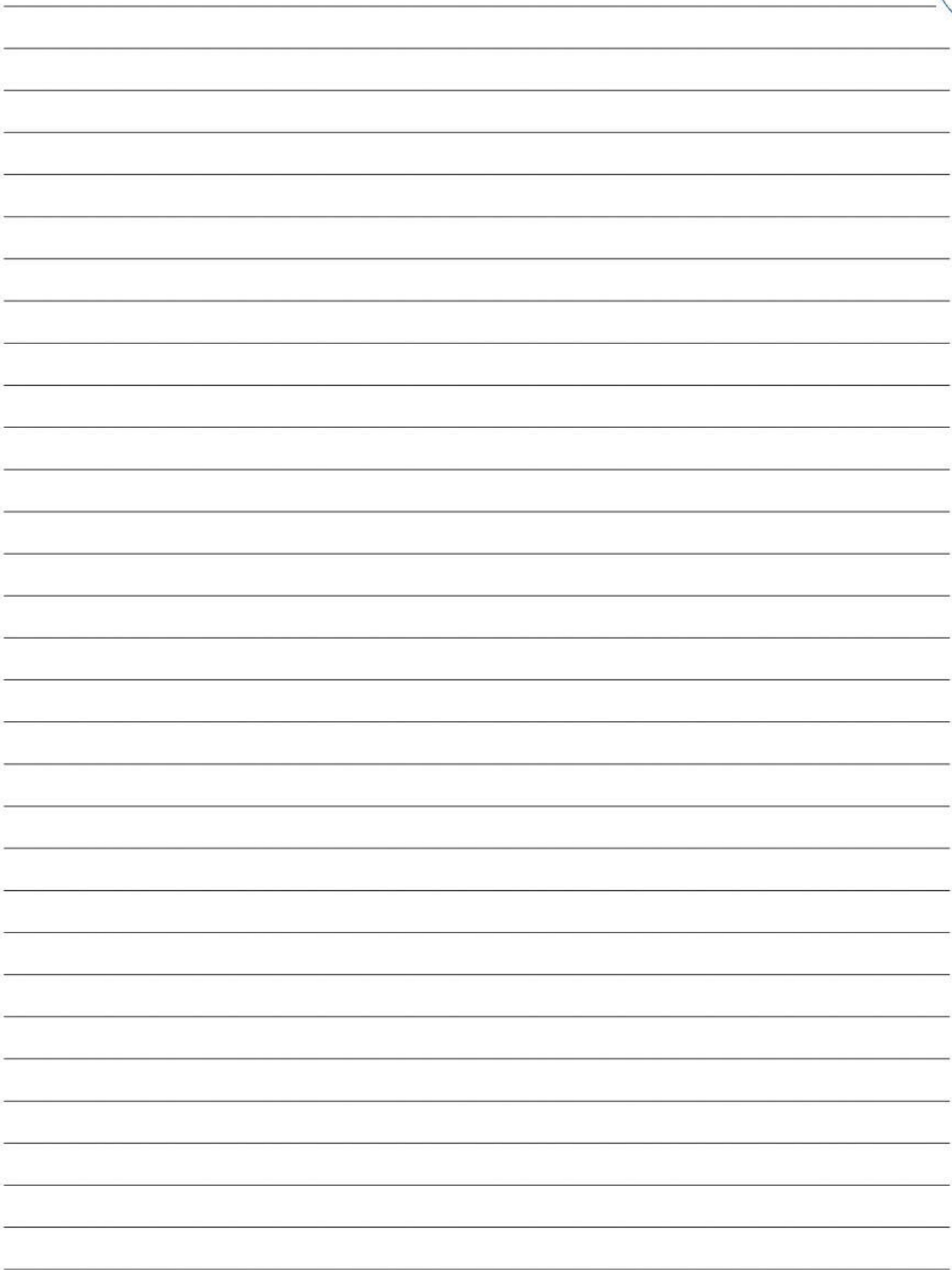

A. GRAMMAR: Adjectives and Prepositions (Tính từ và giới từ)

- Một số **tính từ** thường đi kèm với **giới từ** nhất định.
- Sau giới từ có thể là **danh từ/cụm danh từ** hoặc **động từ dạng V-ing** (vì giới từ luôn theo sau bởi danh từ hoặc động từ thêm -ing).
- Cấu trúc:

	Structure	Example
Positive	S + am/is/are + adj + prep + N/V-ing	They are interested in playing football.
Negative	S + am/is/are + not + adj + prep + N/V-ing	They are not interested in playing football.
Question (Yes/No)	Am/Is/Are + S + adj + prep + N/V-ing?	Are they interested in playing football?
Question (Wh- words)	Wh- + am/is/are + S + adj + prep + N/V-ing?	Who are they interested in meeting?

excited about	hào hứng về	They are excited about the trip.
curious about	tò mò về	I am curious about other cultures.
good at	giỏi về / giỏi trong việc	She is good at speaking English.

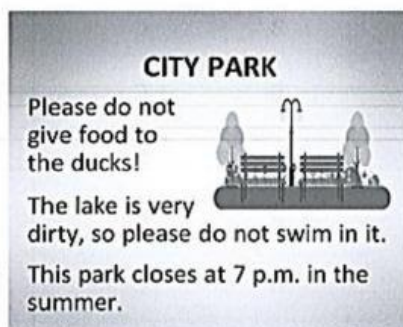
