1. Order reception	A. Attaching information to packages, such as barcodes or destination.
2. Picking	B. Grouping several orders together for the same shipment or route.
3. Quality control	C. Organizing the best transport route to save time and costs.
4. Packaging materials	D. Placing the goods into the transport vehicle in a safe and efficient way.
5. Labeling	E. Receiving the customer's order in the system and checking the details.
6. Documentation	F. Selecting and collecting items from their storage locations in the warehouse.
7. Consolidation	G. The paperwork required for shipping, such as invoices and packing lists.
8. Loading	H. Checking that products are correct, in good condition, and match the order.
9. Route planning	I. Materials used to protect goods during transport, like boxes, seals, and stretch film.
