



Affirmative

They lived a long time ago.

He wanted fruit for breakfast.

Questions

Negative

She didn't live in a house.

I didn't want to go home.

Short answers

To ask yes/no questions about the past with regular verbs, we can use **Did** + subject pronoun + base form of the verb.

Did you start your homework?

Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.

Did they finish the cake?

Yes, they did. / No, they didn't.


Our Tet holiday


