Military Action	Proposed response to defend American interests
Democratic-Republican Party	Key War Hawk leader shaping public opinion
Nationalism	Politicians advocating for war with Great Britain
National Honor	Concept driving War Hawks to support military conflict
War Hawk	Economic issues prompting War Hawk advocacy
War of 1812	Belief in national unity and strength through war
