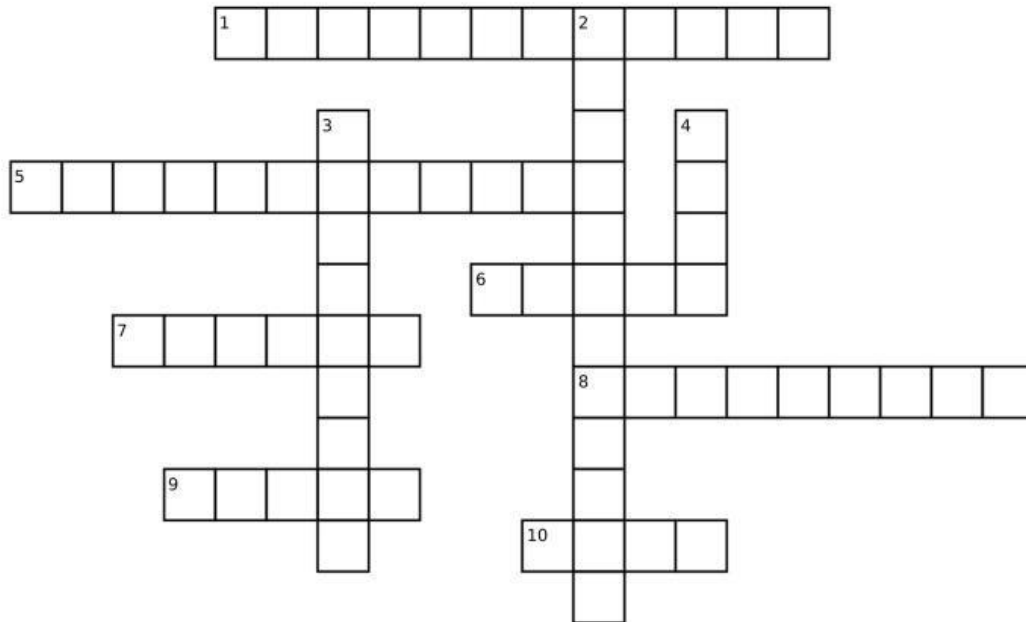


Crossword Puzzle
