In the 1990s, San Pedro de Atacama was a very small village in the north of Chile.

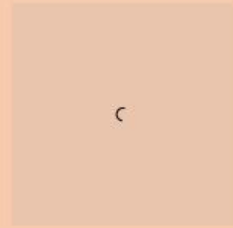
There was one small hostel near the main plaza, but there weren't any hotels.
