

Who wrote a diary while hiding during World War II?



Anne Frank was born in Germany in 1929. She was a Jewish girl. When she was four years old, her family moved to Amsterdam, in the Netherlands, because of the war. They wanted to be safe from the Nazis.

On her 13th birthday, Anne got a diary. She loved it and called it Kitty. She wrote in her diary every day.

In 1942, Anne's family had to hide. They went to a secret place behind her father's office. Eight people lived there in a small space. They had to be very quiet. Anne wrote about her life in the secret place: her feelings, her hopes, and her fears. She wrote for two years.

Sadly, the family was found and arrested. Only Anne's father, Otto Frank, survived the war. He found Anne's diary and published it. Today, people all over the world read Anne's diary. It is a famous book about hope and strength.
