

Recount Text

Definition

A recount text is a text that tells about past experiences or events. Its purpose is to retell events in the order they happened, usually to inform or entertain the reader.

Social Function

- To retell events from the past.
- To share experiences with others.
- To entertain or give information.

Generic Structure

- Orientation → introduces background information (who, where, when).
- Events → tells what happened in chronological order.
- Re-orientation → closing statement, reflection, or comment about the events

Language Features

- Use of past tense (went, saw, ate, visited).
- Use of action verbs (played, climbed, watched).
- Use of time connectors (first, then, after that, finally).
- Use of specific participants (my family, my friend, we).

Example
