Past simple 2nd verb	Events that began and ended in the past	-Ali played football yesterday -She went to school last month	-Ali didn't play football yesterday She didn't go to school last month	- Did he play football yesterday? - did she go to school last month ?	Yesterday – last – ago
Past progressive Was, were + v(ing)	-to talk about ongoing action in the past -interrupted action in the past	I was writing yesterday - they were cleaning my room when he called me	- he wasn't studying yesterday - we weren't studying yesterday	- was he writing yesterday?	Yesterday – last – ago
Past progressive + when + Past simple	- When to indicate that a longer continuous action is interrupted by a shorter one.	Sara was watching TV when the bell rang . (long action) (short action)
