Cooking at home is becoming more and more popular in many countries. Families enjoy preparing meals together because it is healthier and often cheaper than eating at restaurants. For breakfast, many people like to make simple dishes. A common breakfast includes bread with butter and jam, or rice with eggs and vegetables. In some cities, people eat noodles or soup in the morning.

At noon, families usually have lunch together. Lunch is often the biggest meal of the day. It may include rice, meat or fish, and lots of fresh vegetables. People also like to drink soup or eat fruit after lunch.

Dinner is also important, especially for families that cannot eat together at lunch because of work or school. Dinner usually has rice, chicken or pork, fresh salad, and soup. In some families, people enjoy pasta, pizza, or sandwiches for dinner. After the meal, parents often drink tea while children have fruit juice.

Eating together is not only about food; it is also about family time. People share their stories from school or work and talk about plans for the next day. That is why family meals are an important tradition in many cultures.
