

Tenses review

1: Present Simple

used for habits, routines, and general truths.

Example: I play football every Saturday.

2: Present Continuous

describes actions happening now or around the present time.

Example: I am watching a film right now.

3: Past Simple

This tense is used for actions that happened and finished in the past.

Example: I visited my grandmother yesterday.

4: Past Continuous

describes actions that were ongoing in the past.

Example: I was reading a book when the phone rang.

5: Present Perfect

used for actions that happened at an unspecified time in the past, to express experience

Example: I have eaten sushi before.

6: Will

used for decisions made at the moment of speaking or for future predictions.

Example: I will help you with your homework.

7: Going To

This is used for planned future actions or intentions.

Example: I am going to visit my friend next week.
