ORIGIN

In Chinese culture, dragons are seen as wise and powerful symbols that bring good luck. In contrast, dragons in European tales are often fierce and destructive, known for attacking villages or hiding in caves.



Dragons are powerful creatures and difficult to defeat or control.

APPEARANCE

Dragons are usually described as huge, reptile-like creatures with scaly skin and sharp claws. Some have large wings and can fly, while others crawl or walk on four legs.

ABILITIES

In some stories, dragons breathe fire or ice, while others can fly or cast spells. They are clever and sometimes able to speak or understand different languages.

Long ago, people discovered large dinosaur bones buried in the ground. Since they didn't know about dinosaurs yet, they imagined the bones belonged to giant, magical creatures, inspiring stories and myths about dragons.
