Grammar Adverbs of frequency - Przysłówki częstotliwości

- always - zawsze
usually - zazwyczaj
often - często
sometimes - czasami
never - nigdy

Adverb + verb

I **never** listen to music.
We **sometimes** watch TV.

Adverb + to be

He **is often** late for school.
I **am always** happy.

Przysłówki opisujące częstotliwość stawiamy przed czasownikami.
Wyjątkiem jest czasownik **to be** – w takim przypadku stoją one po nim.
