Presentation

Use the present perfect to talk about a past action which has a present result.



I've cleaned the car. =
 The car is clean now.



I haven't cleaned the car. =
 The car is dirty now.

You don't say exactly when it happened. (Don't say *I have cleaned the car yesterday*.) Form the present perfect with *have/has + past participle*.

Past participle

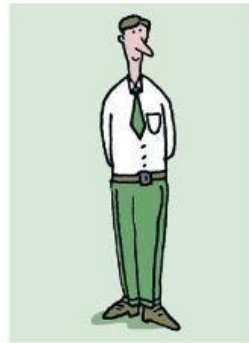
- Regular past participles end in *-ed*:
borrow → *borrowed*.
- Many verbs have irregular past participles:
buy → *bought*, *break* → *broken*.

Key vocabulary **Daily events:** do the dishes, comb your hair, clean your shoes, brush your teeth, take a shower, iron your clothes, clean your desk

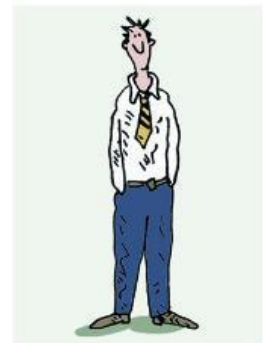
