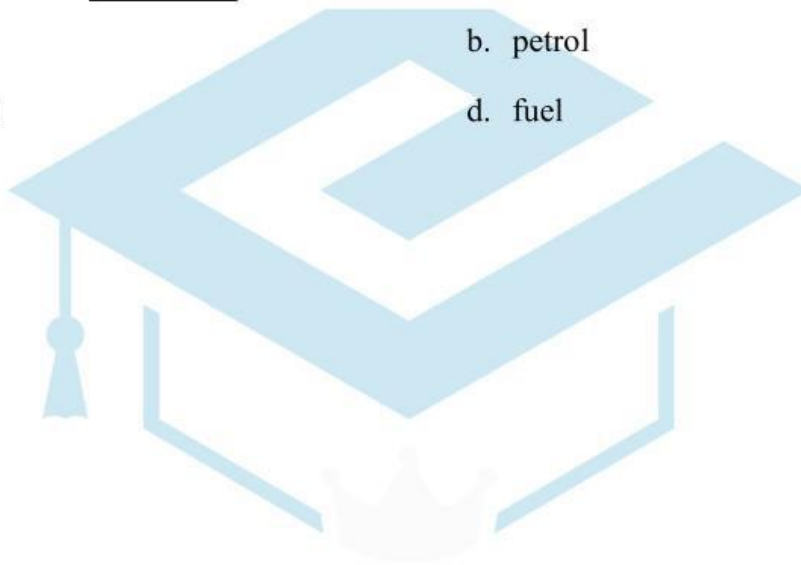

5. What does Tom do when they get back home?

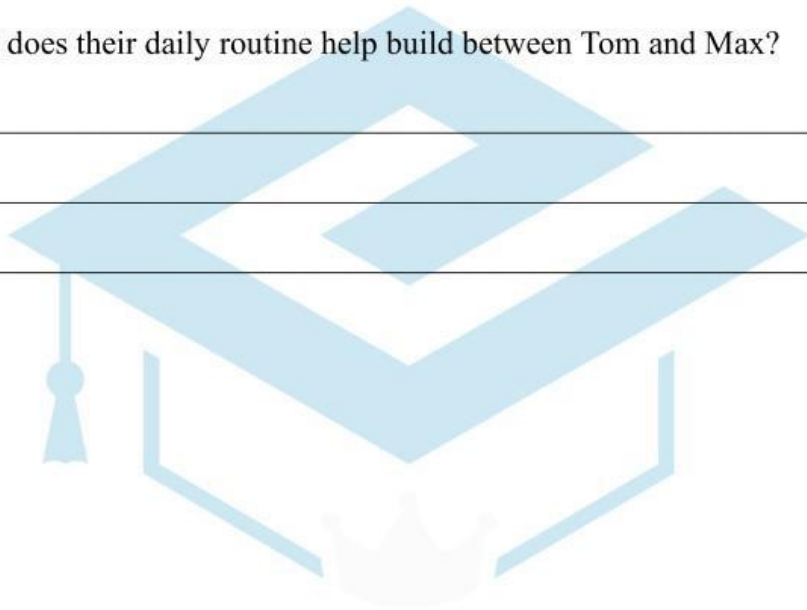

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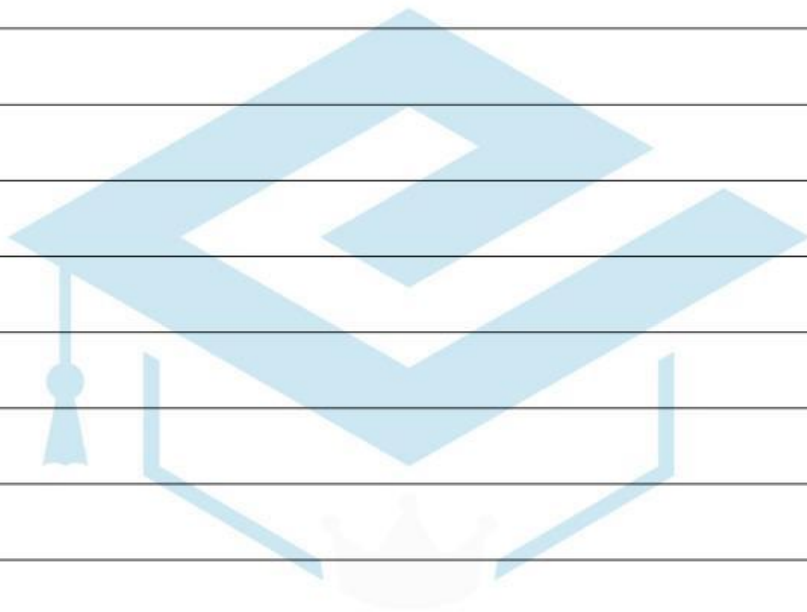


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SECTION 5: ESSAY QUESTION

Prompt: Write about your favorite animal. Describe what it looks like and what it likes to do. Do you think every family should have a pet? Why or Why not?

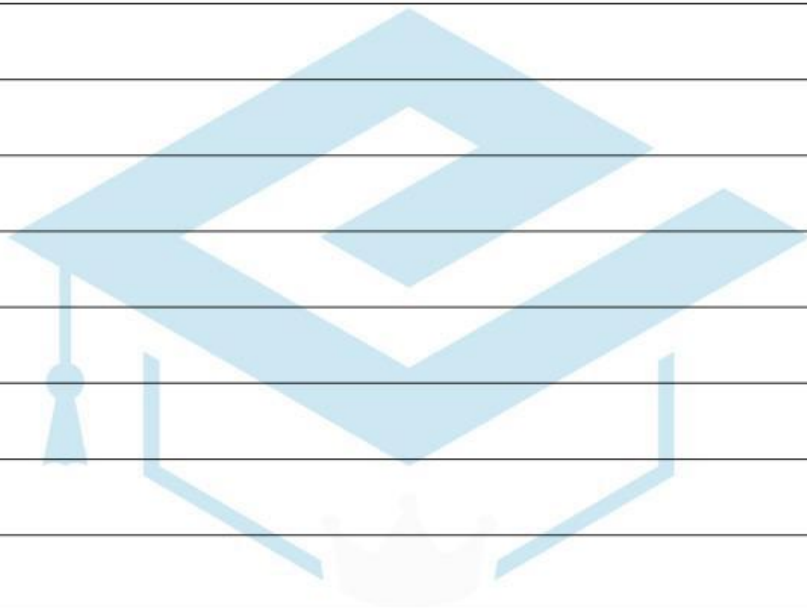


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SECTION 6: PROBLEM SOLVING SKILL
