After that, the students took a "spatial reasoning" test, which measured their ability to remember shapes and imagine objects from different angles. The results showed that students who listened to Mozart performed better. Scientists also found that participating in musical activities and learning to play an instrument can improve verbal memory. The longer the training, the greater the improvement. So, there's really no reason to quit those piano lessons!
