Vocabulary

- wake up – acordar
 - get up – levantar-se
 - brush my teeth – escovar os dentes
 - wash my face – lavar o rosto
 - have breakfast – tomar café da manhã
 - go to school – ir para a escola
 - do homework – fazer a lição de casa
 - take a shower – tomar banho
 - have dinner – jantar
 - watch TV – assistir TV
 - read a book – ler um livro
 - go to bed – ir para a cama

Grammar Point: Present Simple (affirmative)

We use the **Present Simple** to talk about habits and daily routines.

Examples:

- I wake up at 7 o'clock.
- She brushes her teeth in the morning.
- We watch TV in the evening.

Rule:

- He/She/It → add **-s** or **-es** to the verb.
 - I/You/We/They → use the base form.
