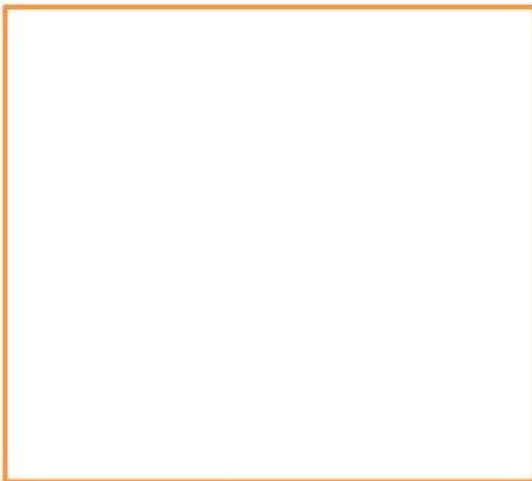


Caillou: All in a Day's Work
