


home (n): the place where sb/sth lives

e.g. The Great Barrier Reef in Australia is **home** to beautiful colourful sea creatures.

insect (n): a small animal with six legs

e.g. In the summer we use **insect** repellent to keep insects such as mosquitoes away.

lack (n): not having something; a shortage

e.g. There is hardly any vegetation in deserts as there is a **lack** of rain.

provide (v): to give sb sth

e.g. Oceans **provide** 50% of the Earth's oxygen.

shelter (n): a place giving protection from bad weather or danger

e.g. The wolves found **shelter** in a cave when it started to snow.
