


Our planet crossword

Natural Disasters

Volcanic Eruptions

Think about a mountain with hot lava running down it. That's a volcanic eruption! It is as if volcanoes are earth's way of getting out hot magma, ash, and gas. People living close to volcanoes must always be prepared in case of an eruption. This is so they can get away and stay safe. Volcanic eruptions can also help to make new land if it happens under the sea.



Tsunamis


Blizzards
