

Affirmative sentences

(Утвердительные предложения)

There's = There is

There's a table in the room.

В комнате есть стол.

There are two chairs in the room.

В комнате есть два стула.

There are some chairs in the room.

В комнате есть стулья (несколько стульев).

There's a table and two chairs in the room.

В комнате есть стол и два стула.

There are two chairs and a table in the room.

В комнате есть два стула и стол.

Negative sentences

(Отрицательные предложения)

There isn't a table in the room.

В комнате нет стола.

There aren't any chairs in the room.

В комнате нет стульев.

Questions

(Вопросительные предложения)

Is **there** a table in the room?

В комнате есть стол?

Yes, **there is**. / No, **there isn't**. Да. / Нет.

Are **there** any chairs in the room?

В комнате есть стулья?

Yes, **there are**. / No, **there aren't**. Да. / Нет.

Yes, **there is** one (chair). Да, есть один (стул).

How many books **are there** on the table?

Сколько книг на столе?

There are two (books). Две (книги).

There is one (book). Одна (книга).
