🔍 BƯỚC 1: GẠCH CHÂN TỪ KHÓA (Underline keywords)

Mục tiêu: Nhìn rõ câu đang nói về nội dung gì.

Ví dụ: Kostas likes films that have nothing to do with real life. He loves fantasy and special effects. He has a really good imagination and so he likes very creative stories.

Câu đang hỏi về preference (sở thích/sự lựa chọn) của Kostas. Anh ấy muốn một bộ phim không liên quan đến đời thực, có yếu tố giả tưởng, kỹ xảo đặc biệt và cốt truyện sáng tạo.

🔍 BƯỚC 2: ĐỌC LƯỚI & QUÉT THÔNG TIN (Skim & Scan)

Skimming = Đọc nhanh để hiểu ý chính của cả đoạn

Scanning = Nhìn kỹ những đoạn gần chỗ trống để tìm manh mối

Ví dụ: Đọc đoạn thông tin D, ta có thể thấy:

- **Skim:** Đây là một bộ phim giả tưởng của J.K. Rowling – tác giả của Harry Potter. Bộ phim trong đoạn có yếu tố phép thuật, các sinh vật kỳ lạ và nhiều cảnh kỹ xảo đặc biệt.

- **Scan:** Tìm thấy chi tiết khớp từ khóa:

- nothing to do with real life → “This is a fantasy story ...”
- fantasy → “...with the help of his strange and magical creatures.”
- special effects → “...the film is exciting and unexpected.”
- creative stories → “...fight the dark powers with... magical creatures.”

Cách dùng	+ Cho những hành động xảy ra trong quá khứ và đã kết thúc trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> He sold his car two weeks ago. + Để thể hiện thói quen hay một điều đã từng đúng trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> When he was young, he lived in a small flat. + Cho những hành động xảy ra nối tiếp nhau trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> She put on her coat, took her bag and left the house.

2. Multi-word verbs (Cụm động từ)

- Cụm động từ bao gồm **một động từ** và **trạng từ hoặc giới từ đứng sau** (up, over, off, etc.).

- Một số cụm động từ phổ biến:

Pick up: nhặt một thứ gì đó lên	Try out: thử nghiệm, thử dùng một thứ gì đó
Run off: đột ngột chạy đi	Put together: tạo ra một thứ gì bằng cách lắp ghép các bộ phận, yếu tố lại với nhau
Run back: quay trở lại, chạy về nơi nào đó	Hold up: cầm một thứ gì đó lên, giữ một thứ gì đó ở trên cao
Look forward to: trông chờ, trông đợi	Call off: hủy bỏ (một sự kiện, kế hoạch)
Go through: trải qua	Take after: giống, trông giống

E.g. She is excited to **try out** her new skates. (Cô ấy rất háo hức được thử đôi giày trượt mới.)
