Harry Potter (from the "Harry Potter" series by J.K. Rowling)	40
Sherlock Holmes (from Arthur Conan Doyle's detective series)	23
Alice (from "Alice's Adventures in Wonderland" by Lewis Carroll)	21
Bilbo Baggins (from J.R.R. Tolkien's "The Hobbit")	10
Winnie-the-Pooh (from A.A. Milne's series)	6

- make an opening statement on the subject of the project;
- select and report 2-3 facts;
- make 1-2 comparisons where relevant and give your comments;
- outline a problem that can arise with some books and suggest a way of solving it;
- conclude by giving and explaining your opinion on the importance of reading books for teenagers.
