- 1 A: What were you doing (you/do) when the phone rang (ring)?
B: I was watching (watch) television.
- 2 A: Was Jane busy when you went to see her?
B: Yes, she was studying (study).
- 3 A: What time did the post arrive (the post / arrive) this morning?
B: It came (come) while I was having (have) breakfast.
- 4 A: Was Tracey at work today?
B: No, she wasn't going (not/go) to work. She was ill.
- 5 A: How fast was the police driving (you/drive) when the police stopped (stop) you?
B: I'm not sure, but I wasn't driving (not/drive) very fast.
- 6 A: Did your team win (your team / win) the football match yesterday?
B: The weather was very bad, so we didn't play (not/play).
- 7 A: How did you break (you/break) the window?
B: We were playing (play) football. I was kicking (kick) the ball and it hit (hit) the window.
- 8 A: Did you see (you/see) Jenny last night?
B: Yes, she was wearing (wear) a very nice jacket.
- 9 A: What were you doing (you/do) at 2 o'clock this morning?
B: I was asleep.
- 10 A: I lost (lose) my key last night.
B: How did you get (you/get) into your room?
A: I climbed (climb) in through a window.
