

### Prepositions of Time («Before» and «After»)

#### **LEARN THIS!** *before / after*

a. The word «before» / «after» means something happens first, and then something else happens later:



*I wash my hands **before** I have dinner.*

b. The word «before» / «after» means something happens later, when something else is finished:



*I have dinner **after** I wash my hands.*
