

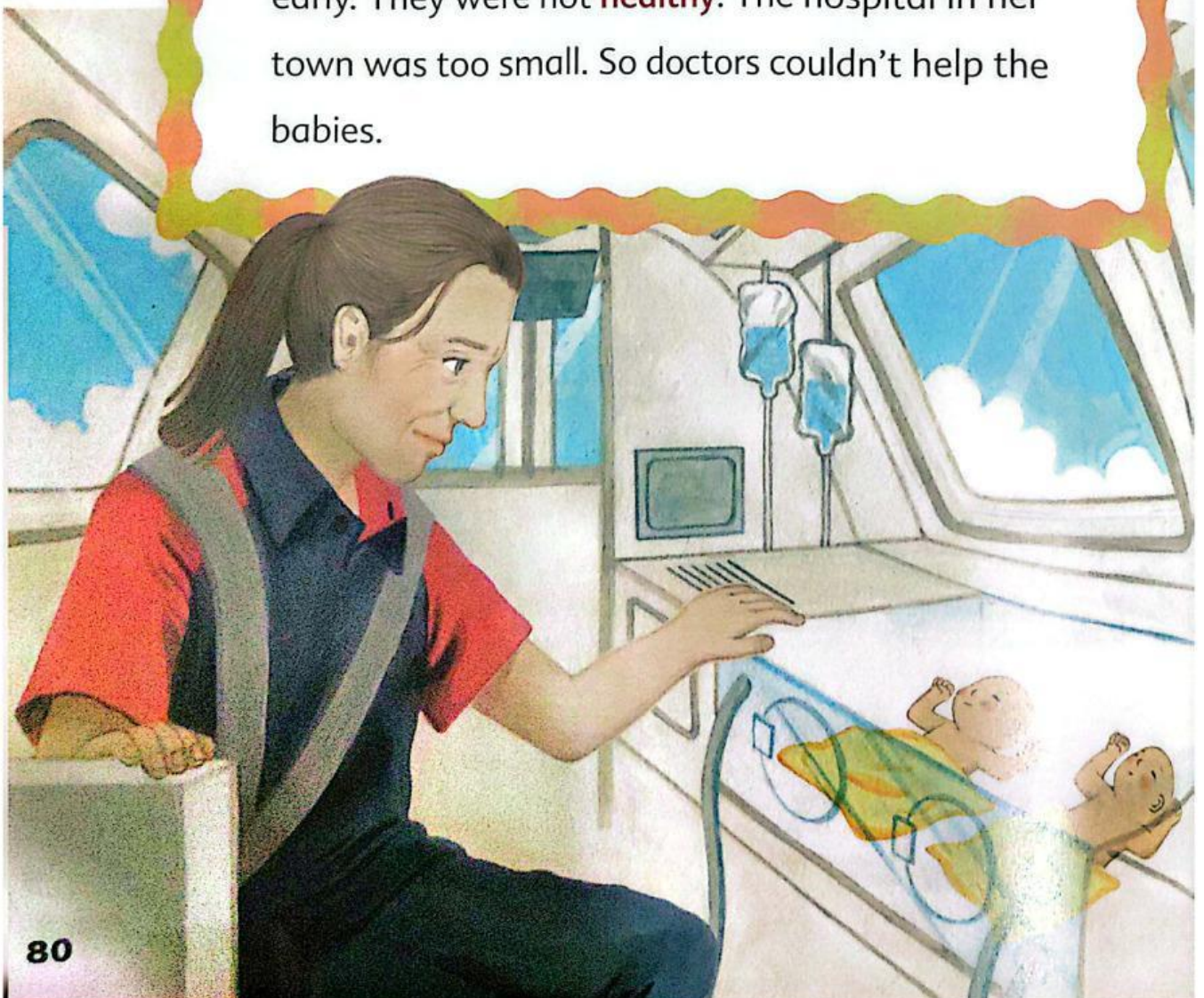
Hospital in the Sky

Let's Focus

How did the air ambulance help the babies?

It's an emergency. But there is no **hospital** nearby. Don't worry! An air **ambulance** can help.

One Australian woman, Amanda Davis, needed such help. She had **twins** but they were born too early. They were not **healthy**. The hospital in her town was too small. So doctors couldn't help the babies.





The doctors called a special **helicopter**. It was an air ambulance. It flew to a hospital in the big city. A **nurse** in the helicopter took care of the babies. They arrived at the hospital in an hour!

Now the babies are healthy. The air ambulance saved them!
