Every year, global sea level experiences an increase of approximately 0.1 inches. However, in certain regions of Jakarta, the annual relative sea level rise can reach up to 10 inches. That's because the tides aren't just rising. The city is sinking.

Pietro Teatini, a civil engineer at the University of Padova in Italy and the chair of the UNESCO Land Subsidence International Initiative, explains that the relative sea level rise is the combination of the sea level rise and land subsidence.

Land subsidence occurs when human activity or natural forces cause parts of the Earth's surface to lower. It can affect both inland and coastal areas. Subsidence can be caused by various factors related to human activities such as pumping groundwater and building cities on soft sediments; however, it is not typically a direct consequence of climate change.

Due to a combination of human factors and unfavorable geography, Jakarta is one of the world's fastest-sinking cities. With over 40% of the city now situated below sea level and the possibility of more intense storms due to climate change, flooding in Jakarta has become so frequent and severe that the Indonesian government intends to relocate its capital to a different island.
