Adjective	Comparative	Superlative

2/ one syllable ending with e Example: wide – cute – nice	→ add r + than wider / cuter / nicer	→ add the +st widest / cutest / nicest
3/ one syllable with one vowel and one consonant at the end Example : hot – big – fat	double the last letter then add er hotter / bigger / fatter	double the last letter then add est hottest / biggest / fattest
4/ two syllables ending with Y Example: easy – happy – silly	Change Y to I then add er Easier / happier / sillier	Change Y to I then add est Easiest / happiest / silliest
5/ long adjectives two or more syllable Example : modern – beautiful - relax	Use more before the adjective + than More modern than More beautiful than More relax than	Use the most before the adjective The most modern The most beautiful The most relax
