1. Ivan the warden's shoes every day.
2. Pablo buttons onto inmates' shirts every day.
3. Sam the other prisoners free tattoos whenever asked.
4. Gino the prison lawns six times a week.
5. Yuri fights between the prisoners whenever they happen.
6. Jack the hair of the other prisoners whenever asked.
7. Ben warm jumpers for his fellow inmates every evening.
8. Jim the tables after every meal.
9. Ali the floors of every cell in the prison block two times a day.
10. Joe 6 oranges for each inmate's breakfast every morning.
11. Ana the common room every morning.
12. Ian 50 kg of potatoes before dinner once a day.
13. Ted Spanish to the other prisoners every afternoon.
14. Ken wet clothes on the clothes line every afternoon.
