



Across

- build something from several parts
- move smoothly over a surface
- talk and do things with other people
- collect several things, often from different places or people
- make a vehicle move more slowly or stop
- be in a position where you will not fall to either side
- drive a vehicle backwards

Down

- go past a vehicle or person that is going in the same direction
- move quickly, often to avoid something
- control the direction of a vehicle
- give something to someone and receive something similar from them
- move somewhere by turning in a circular direction
- run after someone or something in order to catch them
