Positive: Subject + have/has + past participle

- I/You/We/They **have eaten**
- He/She/It **has eaten**

Negative: Subject + have/has + not + past participle

- I/You/We/They **have not (haven't) eaten**
- He/She/It **has not (hasn't) eaten**

Questions: Have/Has + subject + past participle

- **Have you eaten?**
 - **Has she eaten?**
