

1. Interested (in sb/sth) : wanting to know or hear more about sth/sb ;enjoying or liking sth/sb

E.G.= Are you interested in cats?

2. (be) into (sth) : very interested in sth, for example as a hobby:

E.G.= I am really into canoeing.

3. Like: to enjoy something

E.G.= I love skiing.

4. Unusual: not expected or normal

E.G.= A field is an unusual place for a violin lesson.

5. Archery: the sport of shooting arrows

E.G.= The centre offers archery courses.

6. Get dressed: to put clothes on yourself

E.G.= I got dressed and had my breakfast

7. Have a shower: to wash yourself by standing under water that falls from above you

E.G.= I had a shower after the tennis match?

8. Have breakfast : to eat the first meal of the day

E.G.= I never have breakfast.

9. Have dinner: to eat the largest meal of the day, usually in the evening.

E.G. = What time do you usually have dinner ?

10. Have lunch

E.G. = to eat meal that you eat in middle of the day.

11. (do) homework: work that a teacher gives to you to do at home

E.G. = Have you done your French homework?

12. Citizenship: the study of the responsibilities and rights of the people in a country.

E.G. = We have citizenship classes twice a week.

13. Drama: the study of plays and acting

E.G. = Mrs Weston teaches drama at our scholl.

14. PE: physical education: sport and exercise that are done as a subject at school.

E.G. = We have PE on Thursday.

15. (by) bike: a bicycle; a vehicle with two wheels. You sit on it and move your legs to make the wheels turn

E.G.= I go to school by bike.

16. (by) bus: a large vehicle that carries a lot of people along the road and stops often, so they can get on and off.

E.G. = We went to town by bus.

17. (by) car: a vehicle that carries a lot of people along the road and stops often, so they can get on and off.

E.G. =She travels to work by car.

18. On foot: walking

E.G. = We will go on foot.

19. (by) plane: an aeroplane; a vehicle with wings that can fly through the air

E.G. = I like travelling by plane.

20. (by) train: a vehicle that is pulled by an engine along a railway line

E.G. = I am going to Bristol by train.

21. (do an) exercise: a piece of work that you do learn sth

E.G.= Please do exercises 1 and 2.

22. Revise for an exam: to prepare for an exam by looking again at work that you have done

E.G. = I can't come out tonight because I have to revise for an exam

23. (study for a) test: an exam that you do to show what you know or what you can do

E.G.= We have a vocabulary test every Friday.
