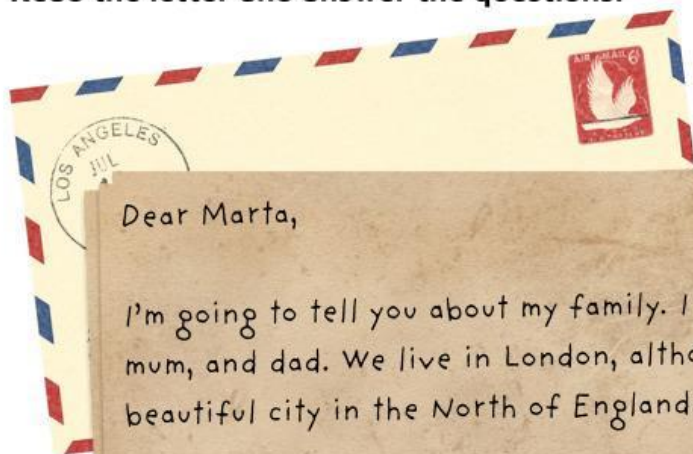




Read the letter and answer the questions.
