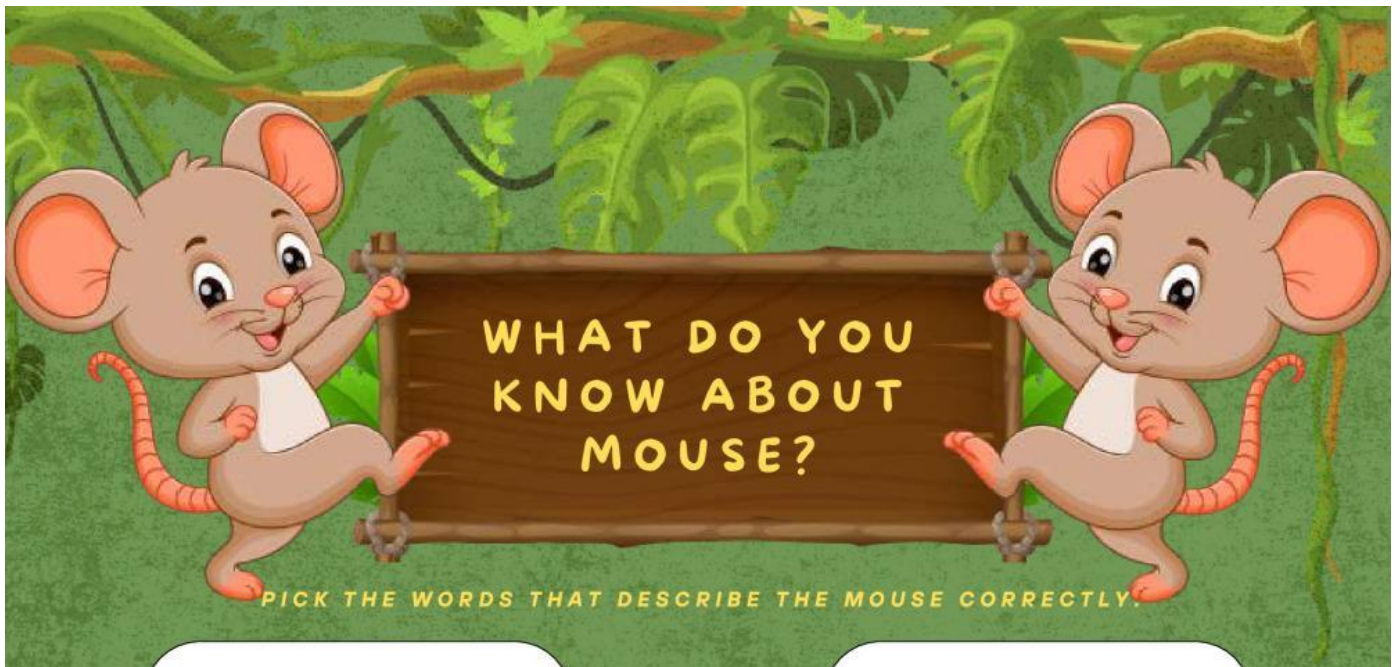

HE THOUGHT FOR A MOMENT AND SAID,

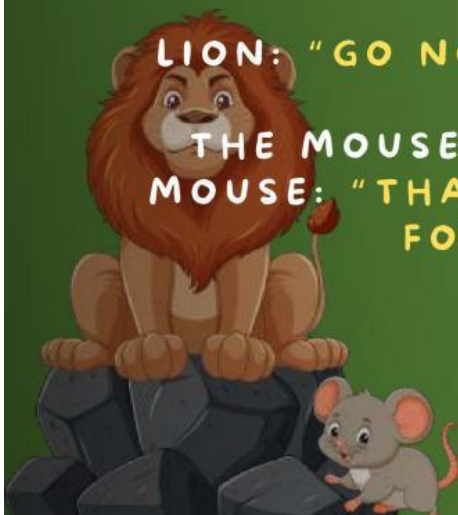
LION: "ALRIGHT, LITTLE ONE. I'LL LET YOU GO. BUT REMEMBER THIS DAY."

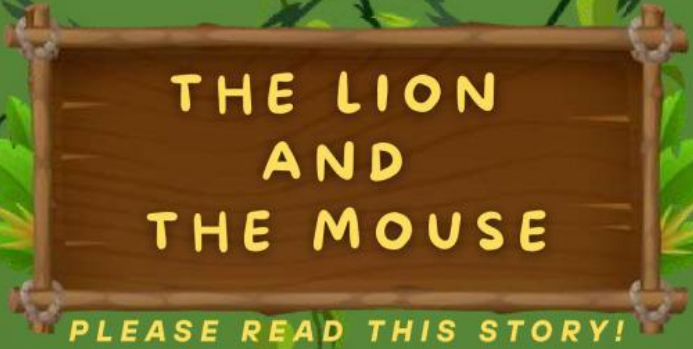
THEN HE GROWLED,

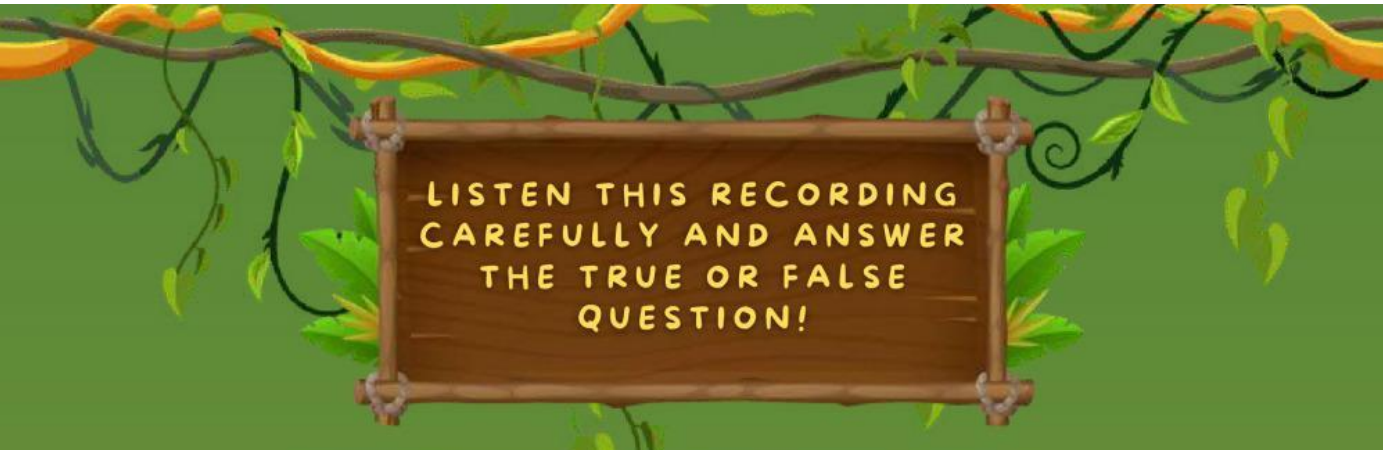

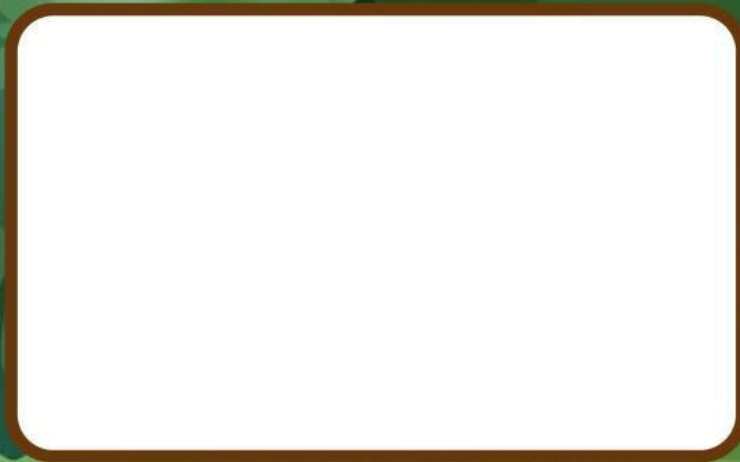
