It was Tuesday morning, and Ben was getting ready for school. He put his books and lunch in his backpack and ran to the bus stop.


At school, the first lesson was English. Ben opened his bag — but his pencil case wasn't there! "Oh no!" he said. "Where's my pencil case?"
