holiday + **s** = holidays

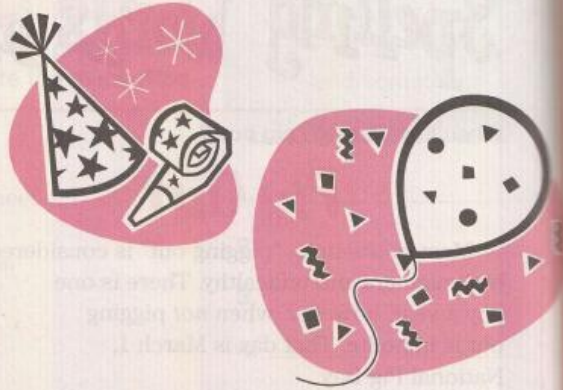
If a word ends in **y** preceded by a consonant, change **y** to **i** and add **es**.
