



Human Body

The human body is a wonderful machine with many parts. Read the clues given and name the parts of the body. Pick the answers from the Help box :

- 1 This organ, which lies behind the stomach on the left side of the body, produces juices called enzymes, which help the body to digest food.
- 2 This pea-shaped organ situated beneath the liver stores concentrated bile and plays an important role in the digestion of food.
- 3 Sometimes called a gullet, this is a muscular tube through which food passes from the mouth to the stomach.
- 4 This is the single largest internal organ in the human body. It produces bile and changes food into chemicals so that the body can grow and work properly. A disease of this organ is hepatitis.
- 5 This gland is located at the base of the neck. It produces a hormone that regulates the rate at which food is converted into energy.
- 6 This sense organ also helps the body to keep its balance.
