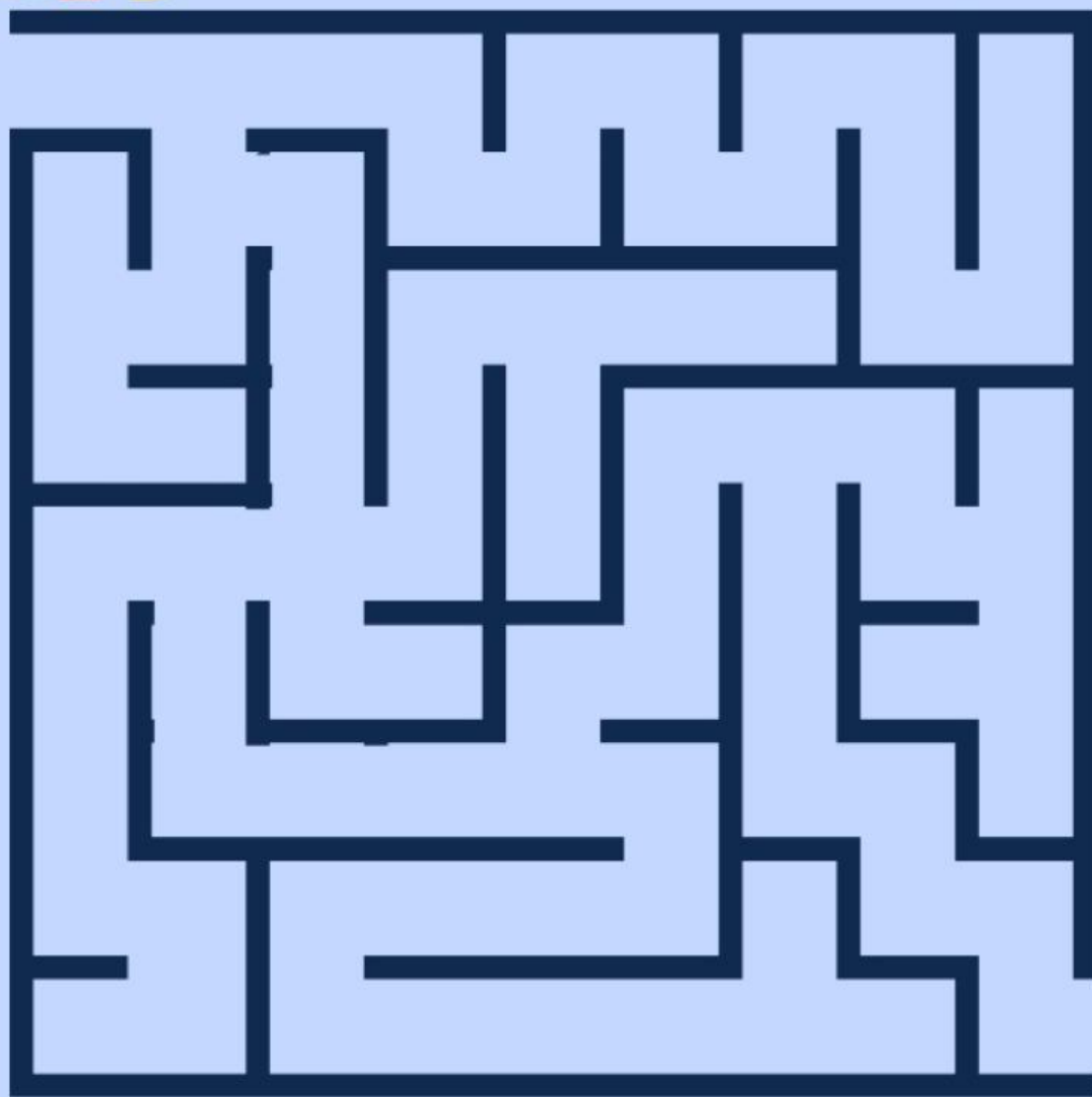

BATIK IS A TRADITIONAL CLOTH FROM INDONESIA. PEOPLE MAKE BATIK BY USING HOT WAX AND DYE. THE PATTERNS ON BATIK OFTEN SHOW FLOWERS, ANIMALS, OR SHAPES FROM NATURE.

IN INDONESIA, PEOPLE WEAR BATIK ON SPECIAL DAYS, LIKE WEDDINGS OR INDEPENDENCE DAY. BATIK IS ALSO A GIFT FOR IMPORTANT GUESTS, LIKE PRESIDENTS OR VISITORS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES.

IN 2009, UNESCO SAID THAT BATIK IS A WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE. THIS MEANS BATIK IS SPECIAL FOR THE WHOLE WORLD, NOT ONLY FOR INDONESIA.

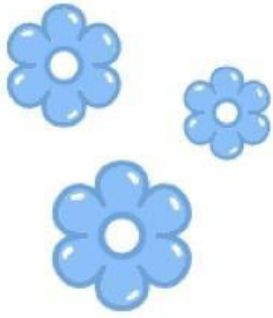

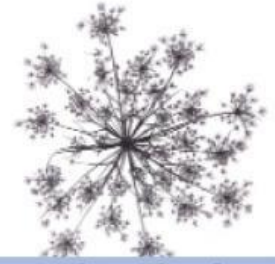
