1. We usually add _____ to the third person singular - **he, she, it**. (e.g. *I like* – *he likes*)
2. When a verb ends in a **consonant + y**, we take off the y and add _____.
(e.g. *I study* – *he studies*, *I try* – *he tries*)
3. When a verb ends in a **vowel + y**, we just add _____. (e.g. *I play* – *he plays*)
4. We add _____ to verbs that end in **s, ss, sh, ch, x** and **o**. (e.g. *I do* – *he does*, *I finish* – *he finishes*, *I watch* – *he watches*, *I mix* – *he mixes*)
