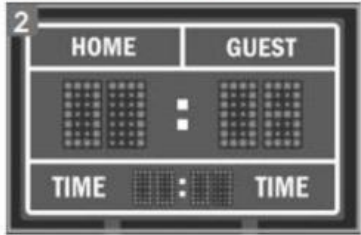

A History of Basketball

Basketball is one of the most famous sports played in the United States and all over the world. This sport was invented by a man named James Naismith, a teacher at a YMCA in Springfield, Massachusetts. He was looking for an indoor recreational activity to be played during the winters.

Basketball is a team sport where two teams, consisting of five members on each team, play in an indoor rectangular court. Each team's objective is to get a ball through a hoop mounted high on a backboard on the opponent's side of the court.

And at the same time, they have to prevent the opponent from shooting the ball into their team's hoop. The ball is usually orange and its size and weight make the ball bounce effectively.

The game lasts for four-quarters of twelve minutes each, plus a fifteen-minute halftime. Since the game clock stops frequently, games run an average of around two hours and thirty minutes. But if the score is a tie at the end of the game, there is additional play time until one of the teams wins the match.

The game can be played by men or women. In 1936, basketball was first played in the Summer Olympic Games. Nowadays, basketball is played in over 200 countries.
