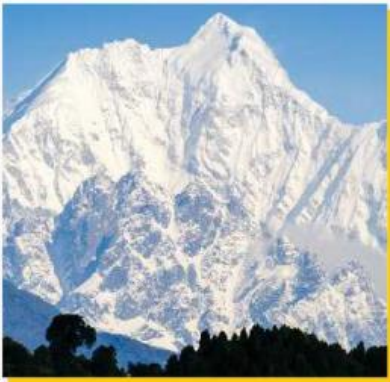


- **Kanchenjunga** is the third highest mountain in the world, its total height is 8586 metres. It is located in eastern Nepal and Sikkim. It is the highest mountain of **India**.

Mont Blanc is also known as the **White Mountain**. It is the highest mountain in the Alps with a height of 4810 metres. It lies between the regions of Aosta Valley of Italy and Haute-Savoie of France. The first recorded ascent of this mountain was on 8 August 1786 by Jacques Balmat and Michel-Gabriel Paccard. The first woman to reach the summit was Marie Paradis. She reached there in 1808.

Mount Kosciuszko is highest mountain in Australia with a height of 2228 metres, It was named by the Polish explorer Count Paul Edmund Strzellecki in 1840. The name of the mountain was previously spelt Mount Kosciuszko, its present name was officially adopted in 1997 by the Geographical Names Board of New South Wales,
