10. This archipelago of volcanic islands around the equator in the Pacific Ocean in Ecuador, is noted for its vast number of endemic species, including the biggest tortoises in the world. These tortoises share the name of the islands, which is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
11. A display of coloured light in the night sky that occurs primarily in the high latitudes of the Northern Hemisphere, called the northern lights or the aurora.
12. A glacier located in Uttarkashi district, Uttarakhand, India, which is the source of the river Ganga.
