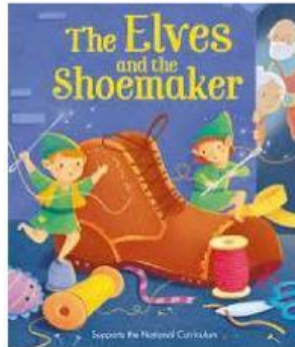

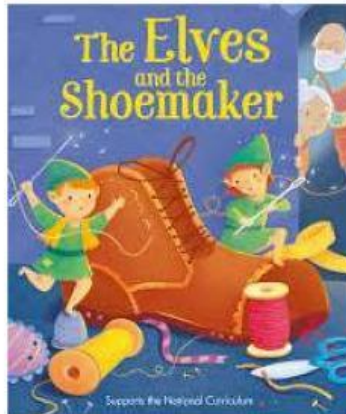
The Elves and The Shoemaker

The Elves and The Shoemaker

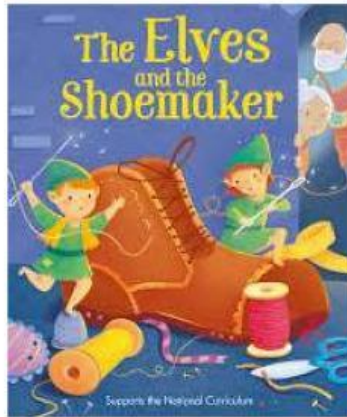
