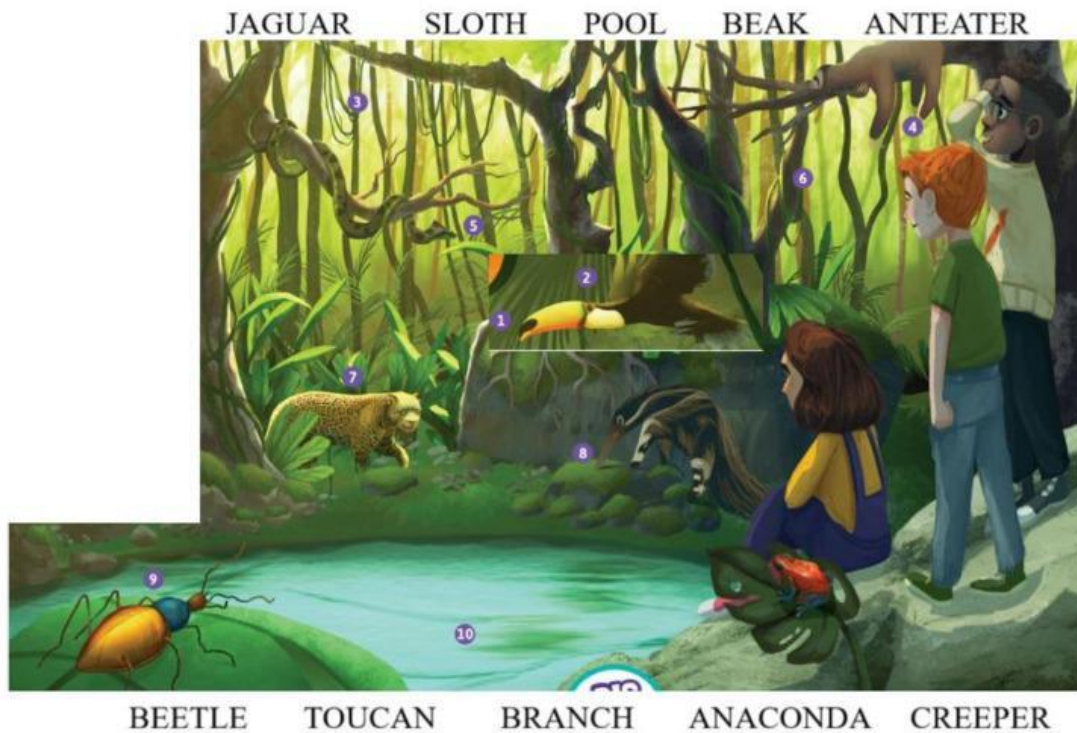

Very cold and windy. Not much rain, but snow and ice most of the year.	No trees, but there are often small plants. There are some flowers in the summer.	Bears, sheep, seals, foxes, birds and some insects.
Cold or hot. Can be wet all year or rainy and sunny. Lots of water.	Plants with long, strong roots sit on the water. Some trees grow in the water too.	Lots of fish, insects, snakes, frogs and water-birds – sometimes crocodiles too.
Hot and dry for half the year, wet for half the year.	Lots of grass, but not many trees. Some trees have long roots to get water from far below the ground.	Lots of herbivores like giraffes, zebras and elephants. Carnivores, like lions and snakes.
