William Henry Gates

Bill Gates is an American businessman who founded the company called Microsoft. He was born in 1955 and grew up in Seattle, Washington. Bill was interested in computers from a young age and attended Harvard University, but he dropped out of his university studies to work on computer programs. Together with his colleague Paul Allen, they created Windows 1.0 in 1985, which was the first graphical 16-bit program. It cost \$99 and required a computer with a minimum of 320 kb of RAM, a graphics card, and a floppy disk drive. This was a big success, and many people started using it.
